The Longville Lakes Arts Alliance (LLAA) was formed and started operating in 2007. We received our new organization status and became a private non-profit 501(c)3 in 2009. The LLAA's mission is *to create an environment in the Longville Lakes Area where the arts and crafts flourish.*

There are at least three arts/crafts expos (selling/exhibiting events) in Longville, one each in June, July and September, with music and/or other entertainment coordinated with the local chamber of commerce. Occasional festival and theater-type events are featured to augment the monthly expos. The Longville Arts Center houses the teaching studio where many classes are offered by a variety of artists and crafters to visitors and residents May through October. In 2011, a new event, "Music in the Park", was initiated. As of 2010, the LLAA began hosting a site for the annual Labor Day weekend events known as "Arts Off 84". Wine and cheese open houses at the Longville Arts Center occur from time-to-time in the summer and fall to allow artists, crafters, members and other supporters to mix and discuss arts and crafts in a friendly setting. The LLAA newsletters, along with the LongvilleArtsCenter.com website, keep everyone informed and up-to-date on various activities and events. These include the latest classes at the arts center where persons can register online or at the center.

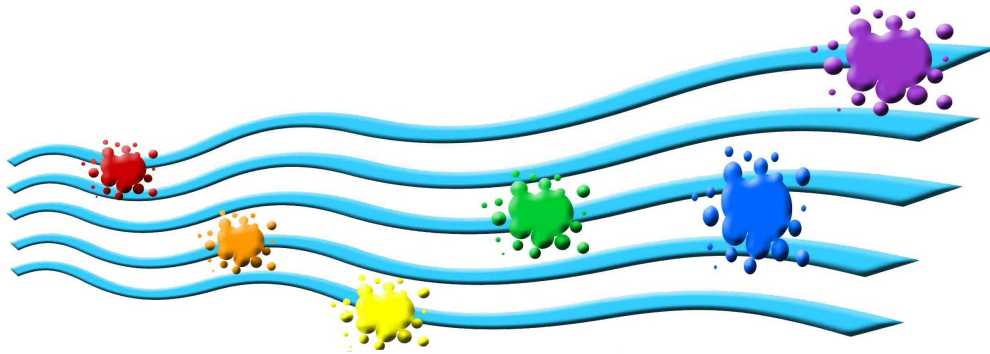
